



Planning an ELA Lesson Using Webpage Resources

	<p>1. Begin with the <i>Year at a Glance</i> document to find out which unit materials you will need.</p>	
	<p>2. Locate the <i>Year Long Unit Pacing Guide of the Common Core State Standards</i>. This document lists the standards your students will be learning within each unit.</p>	
	<p>3. Find the <i>ELA Curriculum Units with Resources</i>.</p> <p>Start with the <i>CC Curriculum Maps</i> (*print edition or web version)</p> <p>Next find the <i>Unit Planning Guide</i>. This document provides the standards for each unit activity as well as the front covers of the books provided by the district.</p> <p>Additional Unit Resources</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Suggested Spelling Sequence</i> • <i>TEXT TALK</i> <p>*RPS documents are based on the print edition</p>
