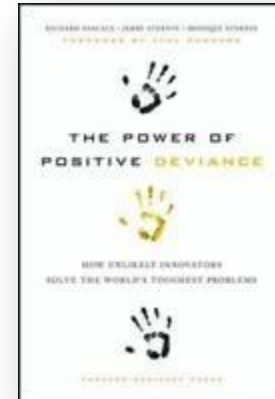

Positive Deviance is a research technique that focuses on finding out what is working. It is most effective in situations where 70% of what you are already doing is working.

Positive Deviance

1. Research technique
2. Invisible in plain sight
3. Make the “flip”



Nine High Yield Strategies

- The teacher who teaches the students to use these strategies will move students closer towards the 100% mark.
- They help learners retain information for a longer period of time. The longer you can retain information the more likely you are to generate a new idea.
- These strategies help learners seek/receive feedback.

Feedback

1. Expert- Teacher
2. Clarifying- Peers
3. Self-Reflective- Self
4. Listening In Feedback

TWIST on Feedback

It is not who gives it, but who receives it.

Students initiate feedback



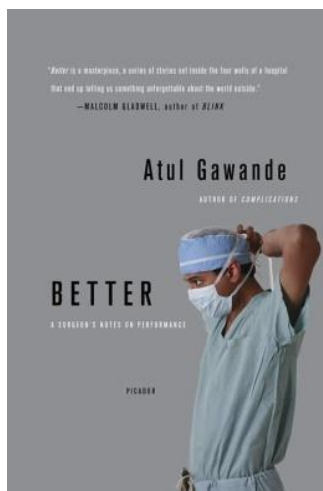
