

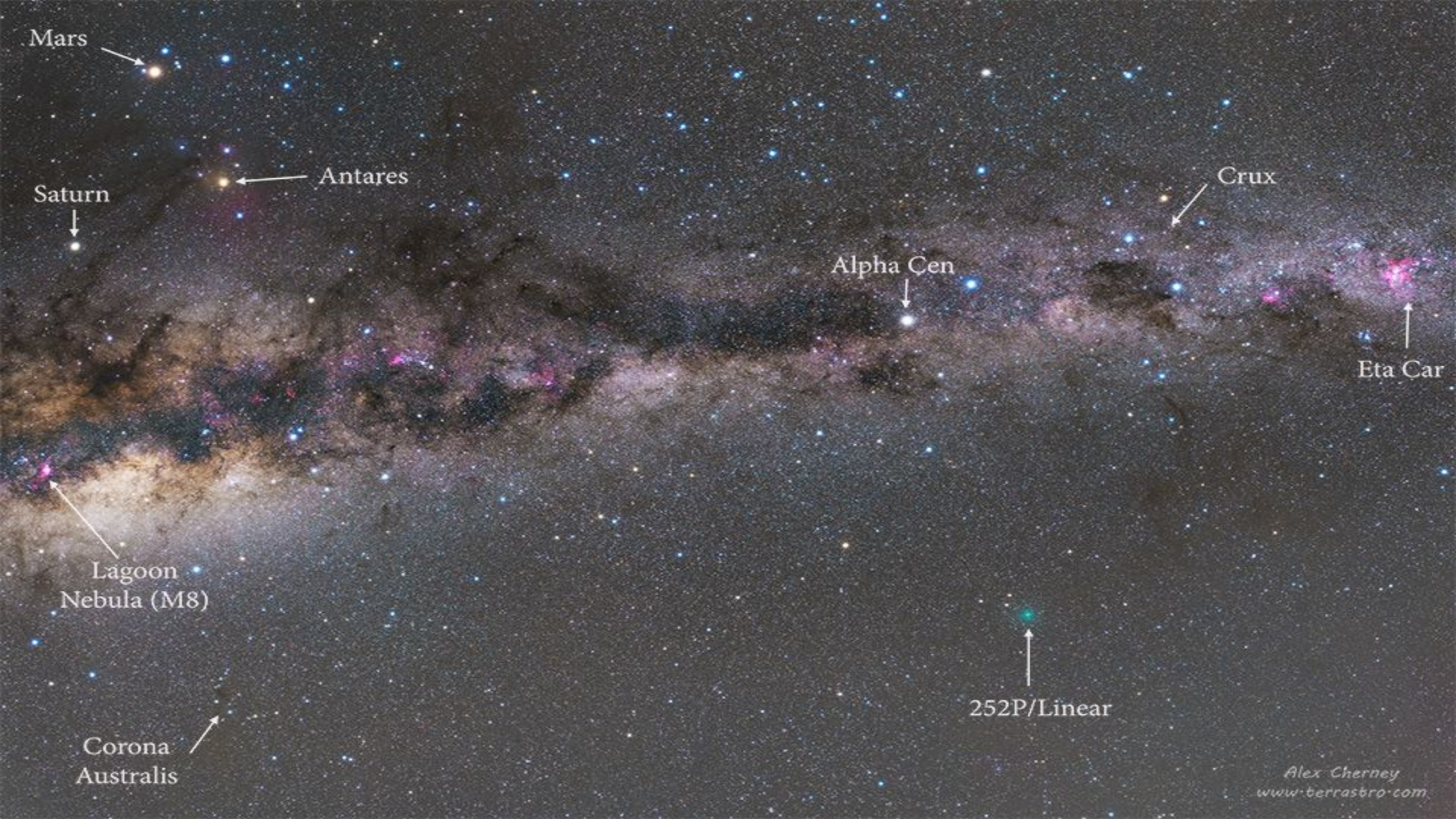
# Stars in the Sky
