Writing #1

(intermediate grades and up)

The eventual goal of vocabulary instruction will certainly include the use of these words in student writing. In this activity,

provide sentence stems for students to complete. This task is only valuable when students go beyond the obvious. The *because* requires students to explain "why?"

Ex:

The boy was <u>bewildered</u> because... The man was <u>perturbed</u> because... The mayor was <u>perplexed</u> because...

This activity can be completed individually, in collaborative pairs, or in groups. Students can also create their own stems and switch papers with other groups.

Writing #2

(intermediate grades and up)

The eventual goal of vocabulary instruction will certainly include the use of these words in student writing. This activity provides opportunities for more extended writing. It is delivered in the form of a prompt.

Ex:

Think about a time when you felt either

<u>overwhelmed, distracted</u>, or <u>inspired</u>. Write a short paragraph telling what made you feel that way.

Think of someone you could describe as <u>meticulous</u>, <u>determined</u>, or <u>empathetic</u>. Tell what that person is like.

Think of when you might need to <u>retaliate</u>, <u>cooperate</u>, or <u>hesitate</u>. Write to tell about it.
