









This document is one example of how instruction can be divided to include all components of literacy. It is fluid in contrast to a block schedule.



Whole Group Literacy Instruction can be organized in any sequence that best meets student needs and class schedule.

	Read Aloud (CCCU) A planned oral reading of a book, poem, or short selection of text, usually related to a theme or topic of study	Examples: Exemplar Text Picture Book Chapter Book Poem Text Talks
	Shared Reading All students have access to the same text An interactive reading experience that occurs when students join in or share the reading of a text with guidance and support from the teacher	Examples: Big Book Poems/Text on Chart Tablets Digital text (LCD projection) Multiple copies of the same text Short Selections of Texts
dbC	Letter Work/ Word Study Phonological Awareness Phonics Vocabulary Word Study Spelling Language Development	Examples: <u>Phonics Lessons</u> (Fountas & Pinnell) Words Sorts • Words Their Way • K Curriculum Page Explicit Vocabulary Instruction • Text Talks • Content Vocabulary • Vocabulary activities from CC units


