



## **Essential Questions**

Kindergarten: Unit 1 A Colorful Time with Rhythm and Rhyme

In this first six-week unit of kindergarten, students are introduced to colorful picture books, traditional poetry, and nursery rhymes filled with rhythm and rhyme.

#### **Overview**

Focusing on phonological awareness, students are challenged to listen for rhythm and rhyming words within the literature. Concepts of print are taught as students read poems on wall charts and in informational books. Descriptions of gathered objects and artworks highlight the secondary focus on color, encouraging rich description, discussion in spoken language, and vocabulary development. In this

early stage of writing, students use a combination of drawing, dictation, and writing to give opinions about favorite colors.




How does rhyme affect the way that we hear and read poetry?
